Jacque Metheny received her MFA from Hunter College in New York City in 1991, and a BFA from Southern Illinois University in Edwardsville in 1981. She moved to New York City that year, where she worked as a graphic designer before entering graduate school. Metheny moved her studio to Hartford, Connecticut following her graduation from Hunter. In her art, Metheny uses repurposed materials to make sculpture that explores mass and assembly and references various systems in mathematics, physics and microbiology. Her work has been exhibited extensively in the United States and abroad since 1982. Prior to her exhibition at Five Points Gallery, she recently exhibited in a two-person exhibition at Widener Gallery at Trinity College, group exhibition at 511 Gallery in New York City and a solo show at 709 Gallery in Pittsburgh, PA. She currently lives and works in West Hartford, Connecticut.
